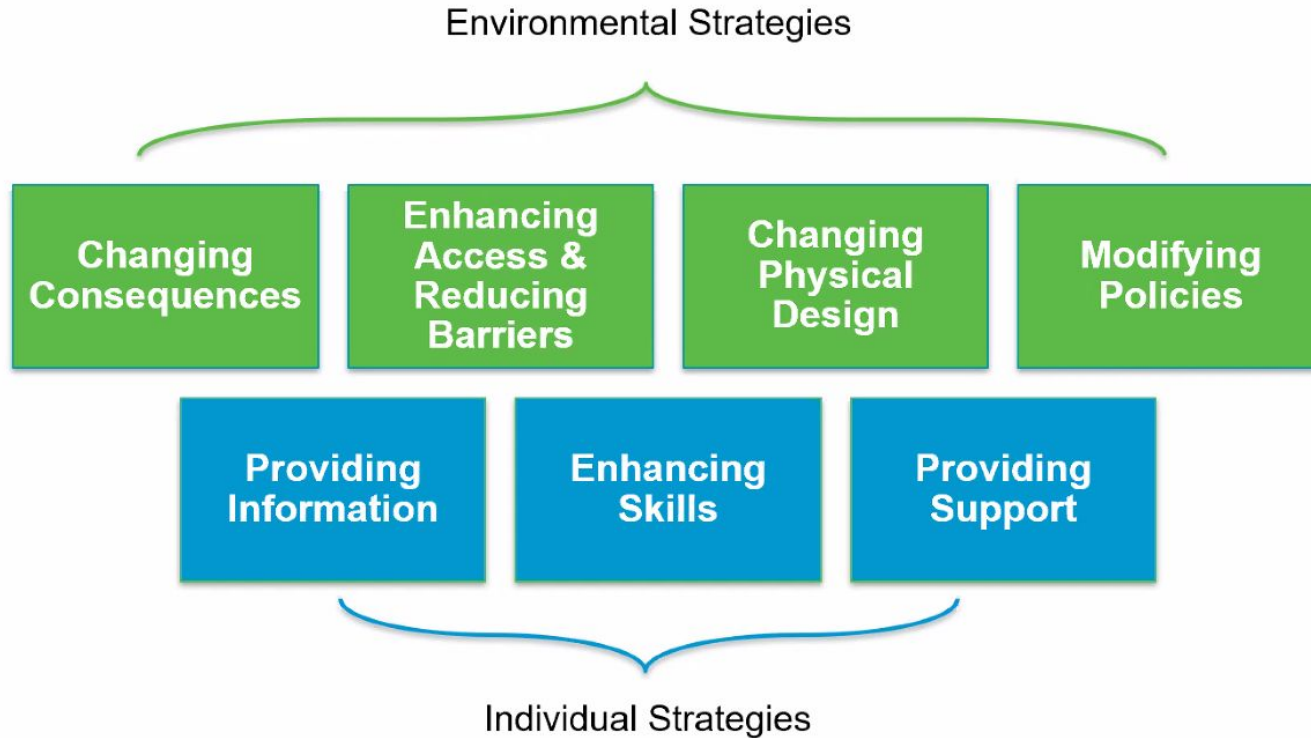
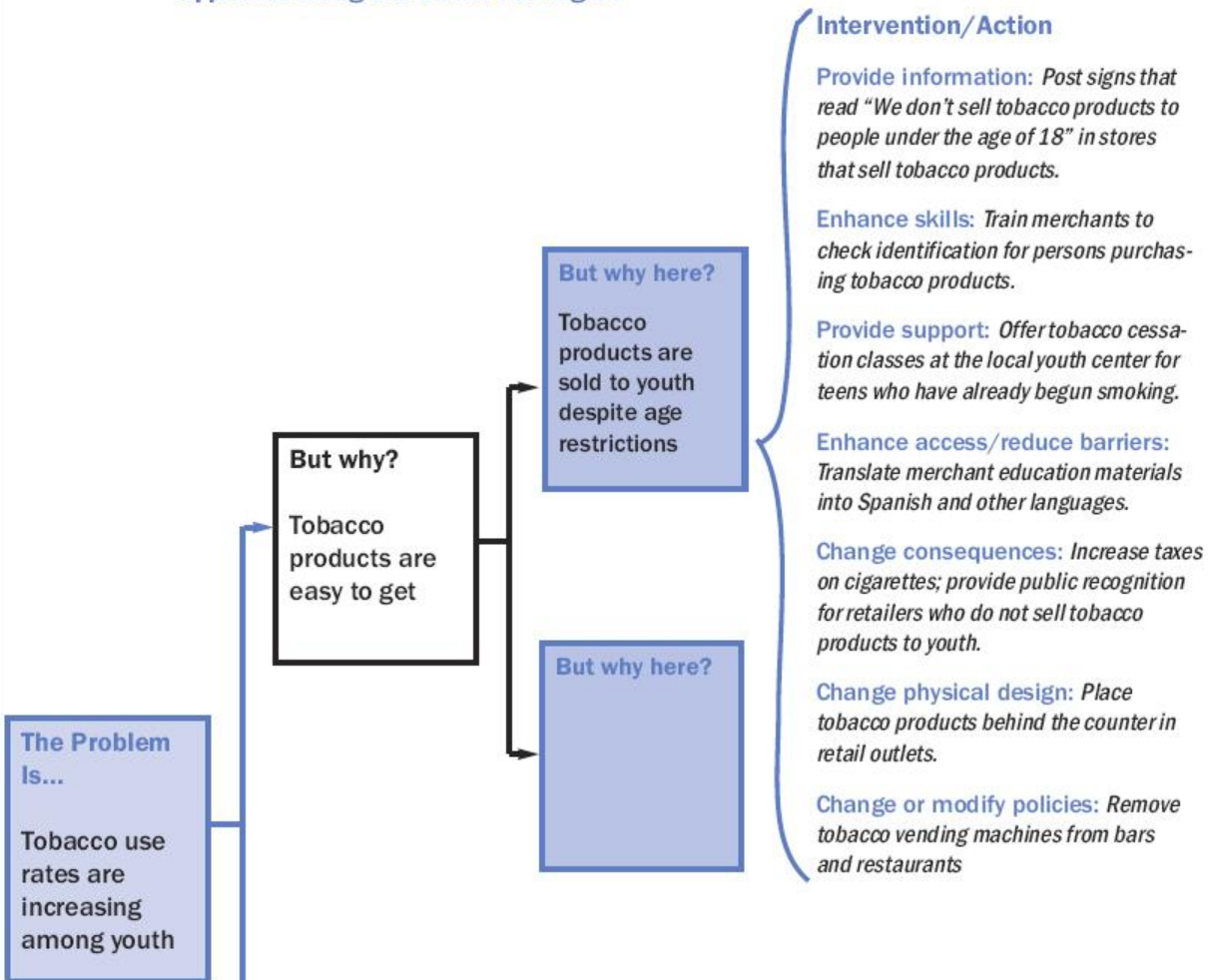


Figure 6: Sample Logic Model for Environmental Approach using the Seven Strategies
